

“In This Manner Therefore Pray”

In **Mathew 6:5-14**, the Lord’s disciples ask Him how to pray. In His answer, Jesus reveals a model that we can use as a pattern that we may pray effectively. We see that He divides prayer into four parts:



Look up at God and acknowledge Him:

*Our Father in heaven,
Hallowed by Your name.
Your kingdom come.
Your will be done
On earth as it is in heaven.*

Ask Him to look down as you submit your petition:

*Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our debts,
As we forgive our debtors.
And do not lead us into temptation,
But deliver us from the evil one.*

Look up at God and give Him His glory:

*For Yours is the kingdom and the
power and the glory forever.*

Stand in agreement with God:

Amen.

The Bible says that because of your faith in the Son of God, you are in the Father’s family. As His child, He wants the best for you. Jesus said: *“For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him.”*

Today, ask the Father in the name of the Son that you may be blessed and that He may be glorified.
