

Justification... Why? How? What?

Introduction: The Bible teaches that are two spiritual positions; Saved and Not Saved... In Christ and Not In Christ... Justified and Not Justified. The doctrine of Justification is one of the central truths of Christianity and when well-understood by believers, this amazing move of God's grace releases us into a way of life that is grounded in hope and rests in the peace that only God can provide. To be Justified pronounced to be made Righteous. Let us take a closer look at the Why, the How and the What of Justification as revealed through Scripture:

- Why do we need to be Justified? **Genesis 3:15** And I will put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her Seed. In this first of all Bible prophecies, the Lord announces that there is a great divide between two groups; the seed of the woman and the seed of the serpent. Scripture identifies the Seed of the woman as Jesus. but who is the seed of the serpent? In **John 8:42**, the Son of God reveals that non-believers do not have the same Father as He does.
 - All need Justification to be declared righteous before God.
- How do we become Justified? Romans 3:21-24 Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus. Justification can not be earned. You can't be good enough or work hard enough for it. Justification is a move of God's grace towards anyone who accepts His Son as their Savior. Romans 10:9, tells us that belief in and confession of who Jesus is and what He did results in Justification.

 Justification is by faith in Jesus alone.
- What happens after we are Justified? Romans 5:1-5 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we also have... There is no down-side to being Justified. The enmity that was pronounced upon man when he fell from grace is vanquished and his good-standing in the sight of God is restored when he is Justified. 2 Corinthians 5:17, promises that all things become new. Old things pass away and God set a new life-course before you when you said yes to Jesus.

God has prepared good things for those who are Justified in His sight

The Word of God is profound and sometimes we can learn the words without understanding what they mean. Don't allow Justification to be merely a word that you use. The amazing power of Justification cannot be fully realized in your life unless you make it your mission to gain insight to; WHY this essential Christian principle is necessary, HOW it occurs and WHAT comes with it.
